Description: "How to plan a preventive community program" The Summer School organized by the WHO Collaborating Centre for Epidemiology and Community Dentistry of Milan takes place in Sardinia, Porto Conte.

The course lasts 5 days, where Italian and International relators deal with the main aspects of oral diseases, preventive dentistry and the oral health education.
